Definitions

Provider Country

The UK country of the UCAS Teacher Training provider. The country may be England, Wales or Scotland. See the additional technical notes at www.ucas.com for coverage and trends for Scotland.

Programme Type

The type of programme the application was made to. The programme type may be higher education, SCITT, School Direct or School Direct (salaried).

Acceptance route

Apply route through which an applicant was accepted. Applicants may make up to three applications through Apply 1 and one application at a time through Apply 2.

Cycle year

The application year in which the application was processed.

Acceptances

An acceptance is defined as an applicant who has been accepted to start a programme through the UCAS Teacher Training scheme.
