Number of Apply 1 Choices

The number of applications an applicant has made in Apply 1. An applicant may make up to three applications in Apply 1.

Applicant Domicile (UK/EU/Not EU)

Applicant's area of permanent residence summarised at a high level. This variable is derived from domicile as declared by the applicant. Split by the following values: 'UK', 'EU (excluding UK)' and 'Not EU'. Please note: The Channel Islands and the Isle of Man have been assigned as 'Not EU'. See the additional technical notes at www.ucas.com for coverage and trends for Scotland.

Cycle Year

The application year in which the application was processed.

Acceptances

An acceptance is defined as an applicant who has been accepted to start a programme through the UCAS Teacher Training scheme.
