Definitions

Disability

Indicates whether the applicant has declared a disability on the application by selecting from a list of available options. These options include, but are not restricted to, learning difficulties, serious visual or hearing impairment, physical impairment, mental health conditions and long standing illness.

Applicant Domicile (High Level)

Applicant's area of permanent residence summarised by individual UK country. This variable is derived from domicile as declared by the applicant. Split by the following values: 'England', 'Northern Ireland', 'Scotland', 'Wales'. Please note: The Channel Islands and the Isle of Man have been assigned as 'Not EU'. Cycle Year

The application year in which the application was processed.
