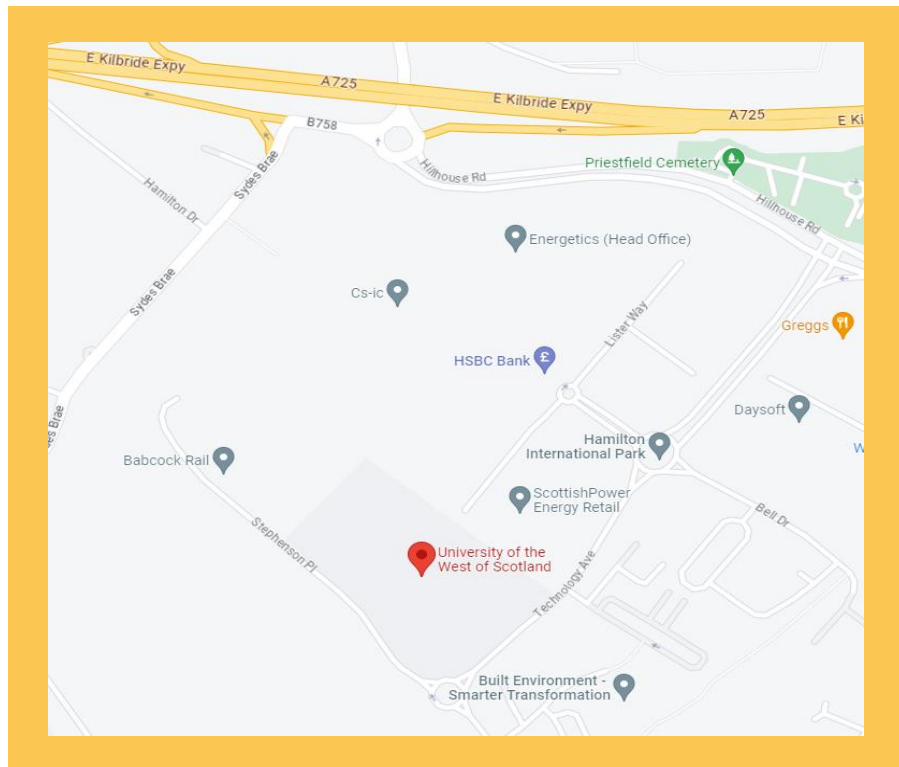

TRAVELLING BY CAR OR COACH?

Free car parking will be available in Car Park 1. As there is a barrier system in operation; one of our colleagues will be on duty, please inform them you are a visitor, and you will be given access to the car park. Once parked, please make your way to Level 3 where the exhibition will take place. To exit the car park, simply drive towards the exit barrier, this will lift automatically as you approach.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE



On arrival, please head to the main entrance located at Level 3 to check in. Please have your ticket ready for inspection. If you don't have a ticket on arrival, please report to the registration desk. Once checked in, please head to Level 2 to the main exhibition area.



Your exhibition ticket is personal to you and should not be passed on to other group members, as this could compromise the security of your data. To comply with data protection regulations, it's essential that individuals at our exhibitions use their own ticket – both on entering, and when visiting exhibitors' stands. Anyone found to be in breach of this will be asked to leave the event and register again to be readmitted.

Security is present throughout the event. We do advise you not to leave valuables or personal belongings unattended.

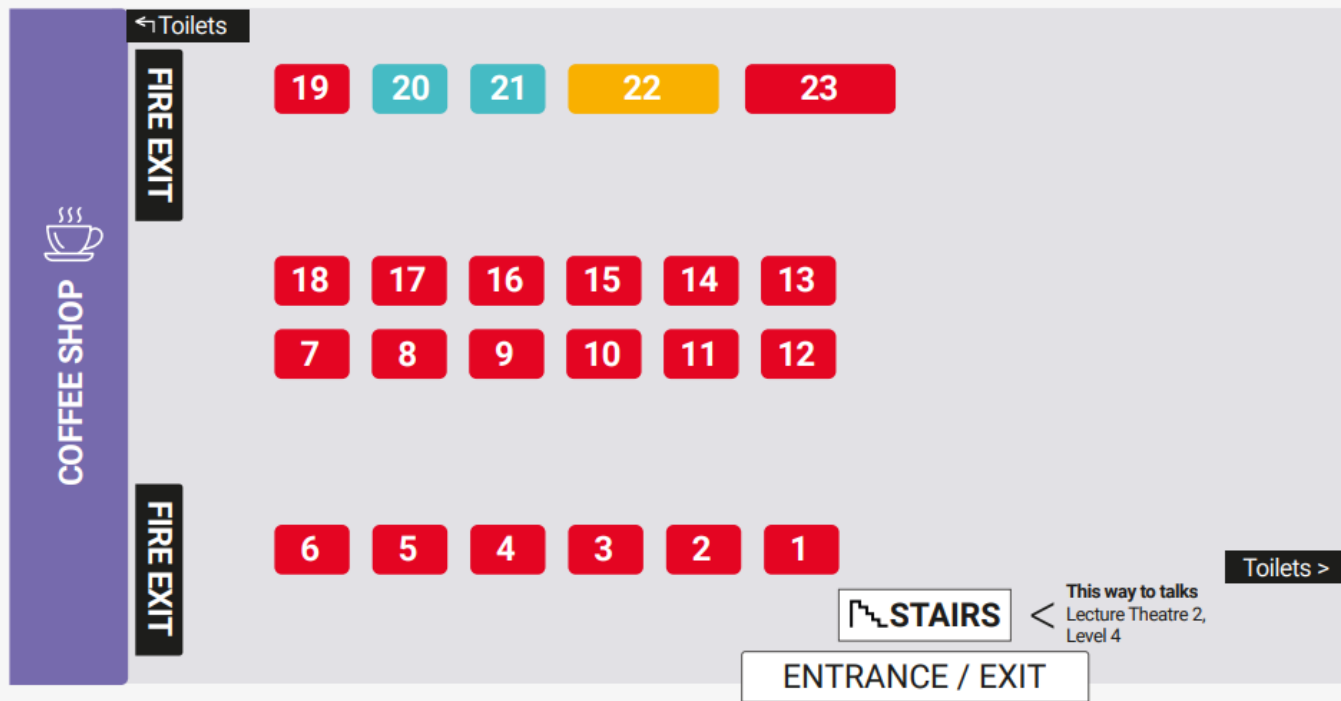
- **WHERE CAN I GET A COPY OF THE RISK ASSESSMENT FOR THE EVENT?**

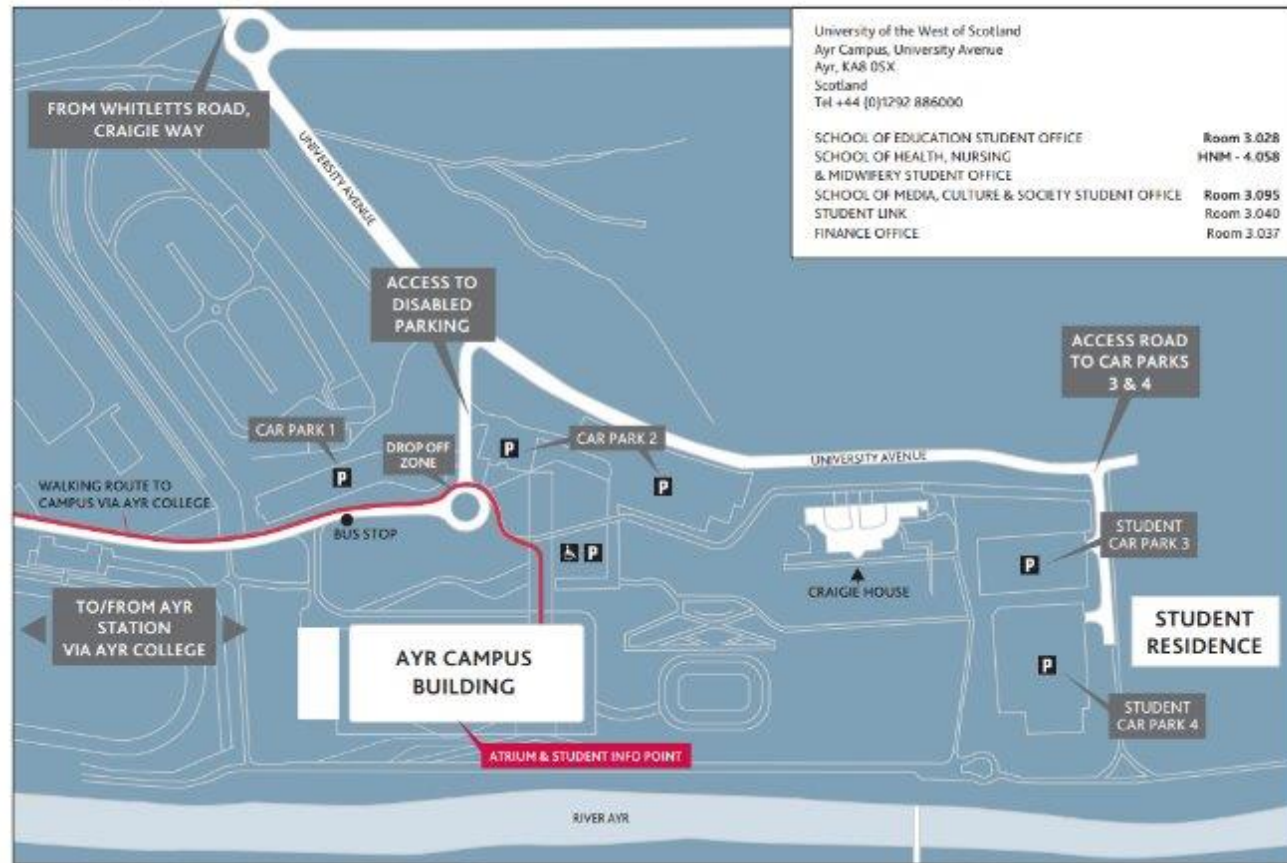
The organiser has completed a risk assessment for the event and this can be accessed by logging in your group booking and selecting the Risk Assessment tab.
