## **D.16 Technical notes and definitions**

Applicants have been able to submit applications for all 2014 courses since early September.

People who submit their applications to UCAS by the January deadline are considered 'on time' applicants for the large majority of courses offered through UCAS.

Counts of the number of applicants reported have been rounded to the nearest 10 applicants, this may result in instances where totals do not equal the sum of the components. Proportional changes have been rounded to the nearest whole percentage point.

The Channel Islands and the Isle of Man are assigned as 'Not EU'. The previous January statistical release assigned the Channel Islands and Isle of Man in the 'UK' therefore the figures for earlier cycles may not match the previous January statistical release.

## Age

This statistical release uses country-specific age definitions which align with the cut off points for school/college cohorts within the different administrations of the UK. For England and Wales ages are defined on the 31 August, for Northern Ireland on the 1 July and for Scotland on the 28 February the following year. Defining ages in this way matches the assignment of children to school cohorts. For applicants outside of the UK the cohort cut off for England and Wales has been used.

#### Applicants

A person who has made an application in the UCAS system during the cycle reported, this includes those who submit applications for deferred entry.

### Country of institution

An applicant may be counted once for each institution country they have applied to. If an applicant has applied to institutions in multiple countries then the applicant is counted once within each country of institution applied to.

#### Domicile

Declared area of permanent residence. The Channel Islands and the Isle of Man have been assigned as 'Not EU'.

### First time applicant

An applicant that did not apply to the UCAS scheme in the previous cycle.

#### Reapplier

An applicant that applied to the UCAS scheme in the previous cycle.
