## WHEN YOU ARRIVE

On arrival, please head to the SportsDock main entrance. Please have your ticket ready for inspection. If you don't have a ticket on arrival, please report to the registration desk at the main entrance.

To comply with data protection regulations, it's essential that individuals at our exhibitions use their own ticket – both on entering, and when visiting exhibitors' stands. # ACCIDENTS & NEAR MISSES


If you are involved in, or witness an accident or near miss while on-site, please report it **to main reception.**
